- ROAM in-resort public transportation system





- This scenic ride will give you an excellent view on the way up and at the very top.





- Animals often seen in town (please keep your distance)










MEET THE BOSS


- The Boss, formally known by his identification number, Bear 122, is an adult male grizzly bear weighing over 600lbs (272kg) who lives in the vicinity of the town.
- Estimated to be around 20 years old, he's the biggest bear in Banff National Park and iconic to the area.
 - The boss is the most dominant and toughest male grizzly bear in the Bow Valley.
- His rival in the area is another grizzly known as Split Lip.
- As dominant as he is, I'm sure you agree he's adorable "from a distance".












LAKE LOUISE
